



Expressions of Interest are invited for stall sites for the 2022 National Penny Farthing Championships

Expressions of interest are invited for food business stall sites for the Penny Farthing Championships, held in Evandale, on Saturday 19 February 2022. The committee will carefully consider all applications, and successful applicants will be required to provide additional information and payment prior to the event. **Applications close on 1 December 2021.**

Due to Covid-19 event restrictions, the 2022 event will have patrons capped at 1000. The village fair component will not be held, and food stalls will instead be positioned around the racing circuit. As a result, preference will be given to stalls who do not need power supplied. Stallholders are encouraged to wear costume – either to a colonial theme, or to compliment the goods they have for sale.

A site location map will be forwarded early in February.

If your application is unsuccessful, you will be notified in writing.

Power and Gas

Power outlets are limited and once allocated, further power cannot be provided on the day.

An earth leakage - circuit breaker with **current** certification tag must be fitted to your power extension lead. Gas is preferred and **external generators are not approved due to noise (unless silent)**. Please indicate your preference in your application.

On the Day

A tax invoice will be issued on acceptance of your application.

Payment must be received before 28 January 2022.

To comply with Council and insurance company regulations, all stallholders must have a public liability insurance policy, in either your name or the name of your business. A copy of your Certificate of Currency is to be included with your application. **This certificate must be valid for the period covering 19 February 2022.**

Food stalls must comply with Northern Midlands Council health regulations. A copy of the current food business permit must be forwarded, either from Northern Midlands or your local council.

It is a requirement of all stallholders in 2022 to supply a Covid-19 Safety Plan for your stall. You may wish to use the *Covid-19 Safety Plan Events Template* available on the WorkSafe Tasmania website, www.worksafe.tas.gov.au

Due to the uncertainty of Covid-19, payment will be negotiated if the National Penny Farthing Championships is cancelled within 2 weeks of the event.

Stall sites will be available from 6am. All vehicles must be removed from the site and parked in the designated areas before the road closure takes effect at 9am. Vehicles can be returned when the Fair finishes at 4pm.
